

# Make a Fairy Skirt

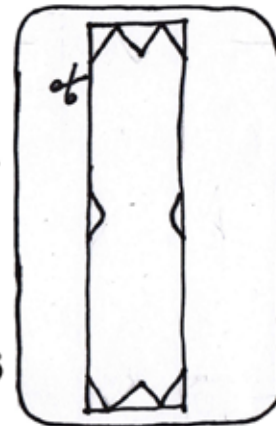
What you will need:

- 3 different shades of blue net: 3m30 of each.
- White 1" elastic.
- Blue patterned fabric.
- 1 sheet of Bondaweb.
- Scissors.



1. Fold each length of net into 4. Cut each shade into 3 pieces of 1m10 each. You will have 9 (3 of each colour) pieces in total, comprising of 4 layers. Loosely pin the 4 layers together to prevent movement.

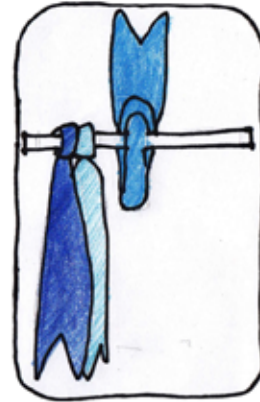
2. With each piece cut a zig zag-shape at the top and bottom and a semicircle in the middle as shown. Cut along the fold to separate the four layers of net. You should end up with 12 shapes like this out of each colour net - 36 in total.



**Please always ask a grown up to help when using scissors or cutters.**

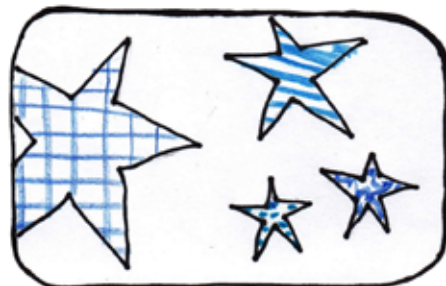
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3. Cut your elastic to the child's waist measurement plus 4". Stretch the elastic between two points and begin to tie the net on by folding each piece in half and passing the ends through the loop made. Pull the knot nice and tight.



4. Continue to tie the pieces onto the elastic, alternating the colour of net each time. When complete bring the two ends of elastic together and tie in a knot to form a skirt.

5. Iron your blue fabric onto a sheet of bondaweb. It works well if you have some contrasting patterns. Cut out star shapes of different sizes. Peel the paper backing off the bondaweb and iron the stars onto the net skirt



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
